



Kellogg's Honey Smacks RECALL

CDC Warns: "Do Not Eat This Cereal"

The Center for Disease Control (CDC) provided a warning on July 13th, 2018 informing consumers that Kellogg's Honey Smacks cereal should be thrown away or returned to the retailer for a refund regardless of the expiration date. This is because it has been linked to an outbreak of salmonella that involves at least 100 infected people reported in 33 states. 30 people have been hospitalized. No deaths have been reported.
