



## **OSHA Form 300 and 301 Electronic Filing Requirements**

### **CHANGES EFFECTIVE JULY 31, 2018**

OSHA has recently provided updated information with regard to the electronic filing requirements for the OSHA 300 and 301 forms.

OSHA's previous responses to the electronic filing of forms 300 and 301 was that "We are not accepting information at this time." This stance has recently changed, and it appears they are removing the requirement altogether.

Please note there has been no change to the 300a requirement.
