



## **Emerson Tool Company Recalls RIDGID Wet/Dry Vacuums**

### **The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission announced a Recall of RIDGID Wet/Dry Vacuums Due to Shock Hazard**

September 11, 2018

This recall involves RIDGID NXT wet/dry vacuums, models HD06000 (6-gallon) and HD09000 (9-gallon). The orange and black wet/dry vacuum has four swivel casters, a carrying handle, a hose and accessories. RIDGID is printed on the front of the vacuum. The model number can be found on a silver product identification label on the back of the vacuum's powerhead assembly.

The recall indicates the use of the unit should be immediately discontinued as the on/off switch of the machine can become dislodged and expose energized parts posing a shock hazard to the consumer.
