



WERNER LADDER RECALL

Please Check If You Have Any Of These Models And Remove From Service

Werner Company has recalled approximately 78,000 multi-purpose telescoping ladders that can be used in five different positions (twin step ladder, stairway step ladder, extension ladder, wall ladder, and as two scaffold bases). The recall was issued in June, and included five models of Werner ladders ranging in size from thirteen to twenty-six feet when extended. The ladders were sold at Home Depot and Lowes from April 2018 to May 2018.



To determine if your ladder is among those being recalled, check the date code “stamped on the inside of the outer leg of the ladder, beneath the bottom step and a label on the rail with the model number.”

Model numbers affected are:

- MT-IAA-13A-13 Feet
- MT-IAA-17A-17 Feet
- MT-IAA-22A-22 Feet
- MT-IAA-26-26 Feet
- MT-IAA-26A-26 Feet

Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled ladders and return them to the store of purchase for a full refund. For additional information follow the link provided below.
