Special Emphasis on **Hours-Of-Service** compliance

June 5-7, 2018

Dear Valued Client,

Provided below is the link to the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) website indicating the scheduled 2018, 72-hour inspection blitz commonly referred to as "International Roadcheck." International Roadcheck is a CVSA program organized in partnership with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, Canadian Council of Motor Transport Administrators, Transport Canada and the Secretariat of Communications and Transportation (Mexico). Starting June 5th and ending June 7th, state, local and federal inspectors will occupy inspection stations throughout North America, from Canada to Mexico and perform Commercial Motor Vehicle inspections. This is the largest targeted annual enforcement campaign on trucks and buses.

Not only could Roadcheck 2018 have negative logistical impacts on your operations, it can also significantly impact your commercial motor vehicle (CMV) safety performance history on the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's (FMCSA) Safety Management System (SMS) web site. The site, which is public record, combines current and historical safety performance information to measure the relative safety fitness of commercial motor carriers. This information includes Federal and State data on crashes, roadside inspections, on-site compliance review results and enforcement history.

The Safety Measurement System (SMS) evaluates the safety of individual motor carriers by considering all safety-based roadside inspection violations, out-of-service violations as well as State-reported crashes by using 24 months of performance data. SMS assesses motor carriers' safety performance in each of seven Behavior Analysis and Safety Improvement Categories (BASICS): Unsafe Driving, Fatigued Driving (Hours-of-Service), Driver Fitness, Controlled Substances and Alcohol, Vehicle Maintenance, Cargo-Related, and Crash Indicator (FMCSA).

Helps drivers understand severity and time weighting of violations, calculation of BASIC measures ("normalizing" process), and peer comparison within Safety Group Events.

This video will help you train drivers to help them pass inspections and avoid being placed out of service. You will also be shown how to prepare for the annual Roadcheck enforcement program. The following topics are also covered: roadside inspections - who conducts them and why; the Six Levels of Inspections; how drivers should prepare for a roadside inspection; how drivers should prepare their vehicles for a roadside inspection; how drivers should conduct themselves during a roadside inspection; CVSA out-ofservice criteria; results of a failed roadside inspection; and consequences of a failed roadside inspection.
