



California Lawmakers Introduce Bill for Annual Submittals of IIPP

A.B. 1569 would require companies to submit their Injury and Illness Prevention Plan Annually

A.B. 1569 was introduced on February 23, 2019, and has been amended into the state Assembly's committee of Labor and Employment. This bill, if passed, would require employers to submit their IIPP to the state each year. The bill was introduced by Assemblyman Reginald Jones-Sawyer, D- South Los Angeles.

Be advised that this bill is not law, yet. If the bill is passed and goes into effect, employers would need to ensure that they keep their IIPP updated and submit it as required on an annual basis.
