



Deadline for OSHA-Mandated Crane Operator Evaluations is Fast Approaching

The OSHA crane operator certification requirements deadline is February 7, 2019

Dear Valued Client,

You only have until February 7, 2019, to conduct the evaluation of your crane operators. The evaluations must be documented and must affirm the operator's skills and knowledge required to operate the equipment safely as well as the ability to recognize and avert risks associated with the operation. If you have any operators hired before December 10, 2018, you can provide documentation of previous assessments in place of performing new evaluations. The operator must be operating the same type of equipment as the previous assessment. If the operator is working on different types of equipment a new assessment must be completed.
