



## *Porter-Cable 10" Table Saws Recalled Due to Fire Hazard*

### **The saw motor can overheat, creating a fire hazard**

Porter-Cable and the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission have issued a recall that involves Porter-Cable brand 10" table saws with model number PCX362010. Information provided in the recall informs that these saws were sold exclusively at Lowe's stores nationwide from June 2016 through September 2018. The saws are described as having a gray body with black accents and the Porter-Cable logo. The model number and serial number are printed on the table saw's nameplate, located on the back of the saw body near the bottom.

The recall indicates that consumers should immediately stop using the recalled table saws and contact Chang Type at 877-206-7151 from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. CT Monday through Friday or online at <https://www.portercable.com/support/safety-notice-and-recalls/2019/07/25/08/55/porter-cable-model-pcx362010-table-saws> for more information.
