Update and Solution for DBI-Sala Twin-Leg Nano-Lok Edge

3M DBI-SALA Twin-Leg Nano-Lok *edge* SRL

3M Co. has resolved an issue with the energy absorber that led to the immediate stop use and recall of the 3M™ DBI-SALA® Twin-Leg Nano-Lok™ edge SRL issued in North America on July 25, 2019. The update informs that the affected units can now be repaired and safely returned to service.

IMPORTANT NOTICE—The 3M update indicates that at this time the solution is only available in regions that recognize ANSI standard Z359.14

According to 3M Fall Protection “As other regulatory certifications are received, this solution will be made available in those regions. Until your unit has been repaired or replaced, the “Stop Use and Recall” remains in effect and these units must be removed from service.”

The alert informs customers that a green check mark on the front label indicates that the fall protection device is safe for to use. The check mark indicates the unit “has either been repaired or has come from the factory with the revision and is certified for its intended use”

3M is offering to repair or replace affected devices for free, or will issue a refund. To file a claim, go to nanolokedgerecall.com . Product numbers of the affected devices are listed on the website.
