

## Coronavirus (COVID-19) Resources

## Be Informed and Prepared

As Coronavirus cases continue to climb, additional information and policy updates emerge. The level of COVID-19 activity varies in different areas of the country. Employers should monitor local, State, and Federal guidance for changes. Below are a few links to Government and business association's resources for COVID-19.

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) has established COVID-19 protection tips that include, but are not limited to:

- Frequent hand washing with soap and water for twenty seconds or hand sanitizer
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick. Maintain a distance of six feet.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. Cough or sneeze into the "crook of your arm" if a tissue is not available.
- Frequently clean and disinfect commonly touched objects and surfaces.
