## Epson Recalls Power Adapters Sold with Scanners

Recall is for approximately 314,000 units

Recall Date: May 1, 2020

Epson issued a recall for the power adapters that came with their Epson V-serious scanners. The internal part code for the adapter is **EADP-16CB B** and can be found on the adapter label. There have been fifteen world-wide incidents where the adapter caught fire or melted. These scanners and their associated adapters were priced between \$55 - \$80; and sold at Best Buy, Office Depot, Staples, Walmart, and department stores nationwide from January 2010 through December 2015. The product adapter was manufactured in China. The V-Serious model numbers include:
