International Roadcheck is a Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance (CVSA) program organized in partnership with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration, Canadian Council of Motor Transport Administrators, Transport Canada, and the Secretariat of Communications and Transportation (Mexico). It was scheduled to begin on May 5th and end on May 7th. During that time, state, local, and federal inspectors would have occupied inspection stations throughout North America, from Canada to Mexico, and perform Commercial Motor Vehicle inspections.

Due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus, the annual 72-hour inspection blitz has been postponed to later in the year.
