

OSHA Issues Direct Final Rule Revising Beryllium Standard for General Industry

Enforcement Delayed for Certain Provisions

Dear Valued Client:

On May 4th, OSHA issued a direct final rule providing clarification for aspects of the beryllium standard. The direct final rule is slated to go into effect on July 4, 2018 unless an abundance of adverse comments are received by June 4, 2018.

OSHA also announced that it will start to enforce certain requirements of the beryllium final standard including the permissible exposure limits in the general industry, construction, and shipyard standards; and exposure assessment, respiratory protection and medical provisions in the general industry standard.

OSHA indicates it will delay enforcement of other ancillary standards for general industry until June 25, 2018, and plans a proposal to extend the compliance date for those provisions to December 12, 2018.
