

EPA AND WA DEPT. COMMERCE CERTIFIED LEAD RENOVATOR INITIAL 8-HOUR TRAINING

This course was developed by the U.S Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), in collaboration with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The purpose of the course is to train renovation, repair, and painting contractors how to work safely in pre-1978 housing and child-occupied facilities with lead-based paint and comply with EPA’s Renovation, Repair, and Painting (RRP) Rule, and HUD’s Lead Safe Housing Rule. This course also satisfies the training requirements for The Department of Energy Lead-Safe Weatherization Guidance (DOE LSW).

Who needs this certification? Renovators, remodelers, painters, maintenance personnel, and any other workers removing or modifying painted surfaces for compensation (40 CFR Part 745.82). They likely will be taking the course to obtain Washington certification as a Certified Lead Renovator, which will enhance their credentials as private contractors and also satisfy HUD requirements for interim controls training in Federally-assisted target housing. The HUD-related material will be covered, even if students are not currently working in Federally-assisted target housing units. All renovators are potential HUD contractors and should know and understand this information.
