

# Care ATC is open for county employees

Care ATC, the newly opened clinic in Dayton available to provide services to around 300 Liberty County employees, held a joint ribbon cutting ceremony Jan. 31 with the Dayton Chamber of Commerce and the Liberty-Dayton Area Chamber of Commerce.

The clinic opened its doors back on Dec. 4 of last year. It is part of Liberty County's plan to reduce the costs of providing health care benefits to county employees.

Before Care ATC's Betty Jordan cut the ribbons, County Judge Craig McNair led those attending in a brief prayer and then made introductions.

Each of Liberty County's commissioners were on hand, as well as District Attorney Logan Pickett and Sheriff Bobby Rader.

Care ATC is described as a near-site clinic available to all Liberty County employees, spouses, and dependents aged 2 and over, who are on the county's health plan.
