Summary

As Dean College’s network lease approached its end date, the college’s wired and wireless networks were due for an upgrade. The networks were supporting a growing number of users and devices, and the college wanted to maintain its high standard of connectivity in the years ahead. They turned to Versatile to design and implement a new end-to-end networking solution that would fully support its growing number of students, faculty, staff, and guests.

An Ongoing Partnership

Dean College and Versatile began working together in 2009. Versatile’s Methodology Leads the Network Upgrade

When it was time to upgrade the network, Dean College turned to Versatile again. Versatile met with the college’s key stakeholders and began an engagement based on its standard methodology.

Discovery

During discovery, the team identified the college’s key business and technology goals so they had a clear understanding of the college’s objectives. They also took inventory of the existing network infrastructure.

Assessment

Versatile assessed the gap between the existing network and what the college needed. They determined what technology met the current needs, then built in room for growth. They developed a set of actionable steps, addressing concerns such as cost, processes, people, budgets, and technical requirements.

Design

Once Dean College and Versatile agreed on a plan of action, Versatile went to work designing the network architecture. Versatile subject matter experts mapped out the technology plan, paying careful attention to industry best practices.

Implementation

All the up-front planning paid off. During implementation, Versatile assigned a dedicated project manager to guide the plan and keep the project on schedule. Each building on campus was upgraded systematically, one by one.

Colantonio says, “My team physically replaced the wireless access points, however, Versatile did all the pre-work. Their team configured all of the equipment

in their shop; they named the access points to our conventions, configured them with any changes I requested, and got them on-site.”
