PE Uniform: Gr.4– 8	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Royal Blue or White T-shirt - Royal Blue or Silver basketball shorts - Royal Blue sweatshirt & pants (optional) - Tennis shoes <p><i>(School logo required on all PE attire purchase through French Toast)</i></p>

Students who come to P.E. class without the required uniform will be considered unprepared for class and will lose points on their grade in P.E.

ALL STUDENTS	
Socks/Tights	Must be worn at all times. Navy, black, brown or white
Earrings	Girls may wear small studs, no hoops or dangling earrings, Boys may not wear earrings.
Hair	Unnatural hair coloring is prohibited for all students.
Shoes	Students may wear tennis shoes or standard dress/ casual styles such as boat, oxford, saddles or loafers No boots or high top tennis shoes. A brown or black casual or tennis shoe must be worn on chapel days. During inclement weather boots should be removed and replaced with a casual or tennis shoe.
Belt	Black, brown or navy (to be worn if pants have belt loops)

Chapel attire Gr. 1 - 5 Girls: *(see footnote below)

Jumper, skort, and blouse (no polo), brown or black casual shoe.

Chapel attire Gr. 6 - 8 Girls: *(see footnote below)

Skort or pleated skirt and blouse (no polo), brown or black casual shoe

Chapel attire Gr. 1 - 8 Boys: *(see footnote below)

Long pants and dress shirt, (no polo), belt, tie, brown or black casual shoe

Spiritwear days: *(see footnote below)

Students may wear any top with school logo, or may wear a uniform shirt untucked with non-uniform pants/skirts

Dress down days: *(see footnote below)

Students may wear outfit of choice.

Dollar Dress Down: *(see footnote below)

Students may wear outfit of choice, but **must pay \$1**. This is a fundraiser each month to support the Costa Rica trip for the current 8th grade class. It is optional to participate, but if you choose not to donate \$1, please wear uniform.

*** At all times clothing should be**

- ★ **Neat, in good repair and modest, jeans may not have tears**
- ★ **No hats or hoods on inside the building**
- ★ **Anytime leggings or skinny-type pants are worn, shirts must cover to mid-thigh**
- ★ **Anytime shorts are worn they must be fingertip length or longer or have spandex shorts underneath that are fingertip length or longer**
- ★ **All shirts must have sleeves**
- ★ **Sandals, flip flops or open toed shoes are not to be worn to school**

Students who do not follow the above uniform code receive a dress code violation (as stated in the Handbook). 3 violations in a marking quarter= lunch detention & loss of dress down privilege for the remainder of the quarter.
