SCRIPTURE TO READ:

Matthew 16:21-25 (NIV)

ADDITIONAL:

Philippians 2:3-8, Genesis 26:30-31 (NIV)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Do you know anyone who is a control freak? Any chance that you are the control freak in your family or group of friends?
- 2. What makes a relationship with a controlling person difficult?
- 3. Consider those relationships you have, and ask yourself how you got into that situation. Is that relationship life giving or is it life taking?
- 4. From what you know about Jesus, how did Jesus approach controlling people? Give an example if you have one.
- 5. Read Matthew 16:21-25 (NIV). See how even Peter could be controlling and discuss together.
- 6. Ask yourself, what are you trying to control in your life that you know you shouldn't be? If you gave that control over to God, how would it change you?
- 7. Read Philippians 2:3-8 (NIV). How did Jesus relinquish control and what did He relinquish control of?
- 8. How do we give up control in the way Jesus did?
 - a. Check your heart
 - b. Check your motives
 - c. See value in the other person
 - d. Accept humility
 - e. Pay the price for what is right
