SCRIPTURE TO READ:

Deuteronomy 6:1-9 (NLT)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1. Take a moment to recap the message together. What did you like about it, and what did you not like about it?
- 2. Take about 1-2 minutes and share with the group how your week went!
- 3. Describe what your childhood was like; how do you think your parents did in raising you?
- 4. In what ways are you intentional with the spiritual culture or "aroma" of your home? (This question can be answered even if you are not a parent).
- 5. This series has been focused towards our words. Why do you think it is difficult for us to be encouragers?
- 6. Is your home where you want it to be right now? If not, name one thing you can be doing to intentionally lead your home to the place you want it to be.
- 7. What is the craziest thing you have ever done has a parent that has worked? (Feel free to share embarrassing stories).
- 8. Read Deuteronomy 6:1-9 (NLT). What do these verses say to you and about the intentionality of our words in relationships?

Challenge: Remind yourself this week of what you have done well in your relationships, and then be intentional with your words about what you want to see change in those same relationships.
