Tuition



5 Days: \$345 weekly tuition (\$172 for half day schedule 8am-12pm)

4 Days: \$276 weekly tuition (\$138 for half day schedule 8am-12pm)

3 Days: \$207 weekly tuition (\$103 for half day schedule 8am-12pm)

2 Days: \$138 weekly tuition (\$69 for half day schedule 8am-12pm)

1 Day: \$69 daily tuition (\$35 for half day schedule 8am-12pm)

(Extended day options are included in the tuition rates)

What to Bring

Make sure your camper comes equipped daily with a labeled backpack that includes:

- **Water bottle**
- **Sunscreen**
- **Change of clothes** *(including undergarments)*
- **Nut-free lunch with a snack if desired**
- **Bathing suit**
- **Towel**
- **Water shoes** *(sandals must strap onto the child's feet; regular flip flops are not allowed)*
- **Plastic bag for wet/dirty clothes**

Don't forget to label all of your child's belongings. Timberlake Summer Camps will not be responsible for any lost items. Sunscreen must accommodate medication authorization form prior to any application and a waiver must be signed.

Schedule

Camp activities run from 9am until 4pm daily. Morning care is available at 8am and afternoon care is available until 6pm. Families are welcome to drop off and pick up their child anytime between the hours of 8am and 6pm. We ask that families familiarize themselves with the schedule for each day in order to know the best drop off and pick up times, as kids may be off campus on a field trip or in the middle of an activity. Transition periods are the best time for drop off and pick up.

***After 6pm, you will be charged a late fee of \$10 per 5 mins after a verbal and written warning.**

Lunch and Snack

Lunch will not be provided by Timberlake Summer Camps. Please pack your child a healthy lunch. Suggestions include sandwiches, pasta, string cheese, fruit, vegetables with dip, yogurt, raisins, cereal bars, hummus, applesauce or crackers. Staff will not be able to heat up or refrigerate food, so a cold pack in your child's lunch is highly recommended.

A nutritious snack will be provided every morning and afternoon.. A snack menu will be available to view on our website.

***Please Note: Timberlake Summer Camps are a nut-free environment. If students bring any nut products they will eat their lunch in a designated area away from the other students because of nut allergies.**

Spy Kids: July 23-27
