Billing/Athletics/After Care

In order to maintain an effective school, including a wide range of co-curricular activities, it is important that parents pay school fees in a timely fashion. Parents should be aware of three important school policies relating to student bills:

1. Students may only participate in co-curricular and athletic activities after school if their school bill is paid in full or if they have an active payment plan in place. Parents are encouraged to maintain a zero or positive balance so that participation in activities does not get interrupted.

- 2. Students who have an outstanding balance larger than \$25 may be denied use of aftercare. Students who are not allowed in aftercare must be picked up within 15 minutes of dismissal time. Students who are not picked up within 15 minutes are considered a "late pick-up" and may be suspended from school the following day.
- 3. All parents with an outstanding bill are required to have an active payment plan in place before the first day of school. Please call the Business Office at 562-3163 to set up a meeting before the first day of school. Business Office staff will also be available at the back-to-school parent meetings.

Middle School Girls: Uniform Policy Change

Creating an atmosphere where our students can be focused on academic and behavioral growth is essential. In order to help eliminate distractions and provide additional clarity in expectations for student appearance, all Middle School students, male and female, will **only** be allowed to wear navy blue dress **pants**. This change will help all of our students and parents to have a clearer understanding of our uniform policy as well as to remove distractions that can take away from our students ability to be as successful as possible in the classroom and in our school.
