## Motorcycle Accessory Coverage

This endorsement includes changes that affect your auto policy. Please read this endorsement carefully to see how it affects your policy.

For a vehicle to be eligible for this coverage, a premium charge must be shown for Comprehensive and Collision or Limited Collision on the Coverage Selections Page for that vehicle. If Comprehensive, Collision or Limited Collision is deleted this coverage will also be deleted.

### Coverage

We will pay for direct and accidental damage to or loss of **accessories** on your motorcycle for which this coverage has been purchased. **Accessories** include, but are not limited to:

- A. Permanently installed electronic equipment, antennas, and other devices used exclusively to send or receive audio, visual, or data signals, or playback recorded media. Items must be installed using bolts or brackets, including slide-out brackets;
- B. Sidecars;
- C. Custom paint, custom plating, custom seats and custom exhaust; and
- D. Safety riding apparel. This includes safety apparel specifically designed to minimize injury from an accident.

Damage or loss must be to a motorcycle described on the Coverage Selections Page for which a premium charge is shown for Collision, Limited Collision, or Comprehensive (Parts 7, 8 & 9). Damage or loss must result from a covered collision or loss under one of these purchased coverages.

Coverage will not apply for loss:

- 1. Sustained while any vehicle is being operated in a prearranged or organized racing, speed, stunting or demolition contest or activity, or in practice or preparation for any such contest or activity;
- 2. To portable equipment, devices, **accessories**, and other personal effects not permanently installed. This includes, but is not limited to:
  - a. Tapes, CDs, cassettes, DVDs and other recording or recorded media;
  - b. Containers designed for use in storing or carrying tapes, CDs, cassettes, DVDs, or other recording or recorded media;
  - c. Devices used for the detection or location of radar, laser, or other speed measuring equipment or its transmissions; and
  - d. Telephones, CB and two way mobile radios, DVD players, personal computers, personal digital assistants, or televisions;
- 3. To **accessories** in excess of the applicable limits of coverage; or
- 4. To safety riding apparel. This exclusion does not apply if there is a covered collision or loss to the motorcycle.

The limit of coverage under this part is the lowest of:

1. The amount necessary to replace **accessories**;
2. The amount necessary to repair **accessories**; or
3. The limit shown for this coverage under the Additional Information section of the Coverage Selections Page.

The limit for Motorcycle Accessories Coverage shown on the Coverage Selections Page is the most we will pay for any one accident or loss. It is the most we will pay regardless of the number of **accessories** sustaining loss. No deductible applies to this coverage.

The Exclusions for motorcycle **accessories** under Part 7., Part 8. and Part 9. do not apply to the extent that coverage is provided under this endorsement.

All other provisions of the policy apply.

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**Definitions**

On Page 3, the following is added:

- 11. Accessories** Means equipment, devices, enhancements, and changes, other than those which are original manufacturer installed, which alter the appearance or performance of your vehicle.

**Optional Insurance**

- Part 7. Collision** On Page 16, the following Exclusion is added:

We will not pay for a **collision** loss to motorcycle **accessories** or to **accessories** in or upon a **trailer**.

- Part 8. Limited Collision** On Page 19, the following Exclusion is added:

We will not pay for a **collision** loss to motorcycle **accessories** or to **accessories** in or upon a **trailer**.

- Part 9. Comprehensive** On Page 20, the following Exclusion is added:

We will not pay for damage or loss to motorcycle **accessories** or to **accessories** in or upon a **trailer**.

**General Provisions And Exclusions**

- 21. Actual Cash Value** On Page 30, the following is added:

211 CMR 133.05(1), which governs the determination of actual cash value of a damaged motor vehicle, requires that whenever the appraised cost of repair of the vehicle plus the probable salvage value of the vehicle may be reasonably expected to exceed the actual cash value of the vehicle, the insurer shall determine the vehicle's actual cash value. The insurer's determination shall be based on a consideration of all of the following factors:

- a. The retail book value for a motor vehicle of like kind and quality, but for the damage incurred;
- b. The price paid for the vehicle plus the value of prior improvements to the motor vehicle at the time of the accident, less appropriate depreciation;
- c. The decrease in value of the motor vehicle resulting from prior unrelated damage which is detected by the appraiser; and
- d. The actual cost of purchase of an available motor vehicle of like kind and quality but for the damage sustained.

- 22. Unlicensed Operators** On Page 30, the following is added:

If the driver's license for you or anyone who customarily operates **your auto** has been

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suspended or revoked or the driver's license is not valid, we may refuse to pay claims under any or all of the Optional Insurance Parts of this policy arising from accidents that occur while you or the customary operator is operating any auto.

We may also limit our payments to those amounts that we are required to sell under Part 3 and Part 4 of this policy.

**23. Suspended  
Registration**

On Page 30, the following is added:

If **your auto** is not registered or its registration has been suspended, we may refuse to pay claims under any or all of the Optional Insurance Parts of this policy arising from accidents that occur while you or anyone who customarily operates **your auto** is operating **your auto**.

We may also limit our payments to those amounts that we are required to sell under Part 3 and Part 4 of this policy.

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## **RULE 43. MOTORCYCLE ACCESSORY COVERAGE**

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This optional endorsement provides coverage for physical damage to or loss of accessories on a motorcycle, other than those that are original manufacturer installed and which alter the appearance or performance of a motorcycle.

This includes but is not limited to:

A. Permanently installed electronic equipment, antennas, and other devices used exclusively to send or receive audio, visual, or data signals, or playback recorded media. Items must be installed using bolts or brackets, including slide-out brackets;

B. Sidecars;

C. Custom paint, custom plating, custom seats and custom exhaust; and

D. Safety riding apparel. This includes safety apparel specifically designed to minimize injury from an accident. Certain exclusions will apply. Please refer to endorsement **TMA 0004-E** for additional details.

### Eligibility

The vehicle to which this endorsement applies must have purchased Comprehensive and Collision or Limited Collision. If Comprehensive and Collision or Limited Collision is deleted this coverage will also be deleted.

The *Motorcycle Accessory Coverage* endorsement TMA 0004-E must be attached to the policy.

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## **RULES 43. MOTORCYCLE ACCESSORY COVERAGE**

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This optional endorsement provides coverage for physical damage to or loss of accessories on a motorcycle, other than those that are original manufacturer installed and which alter the appearance or performance of a motorcycle.

This includes but is not limited to:

- a. Permanently installed electronic equipment, antennas, and other devices used exclusively to send or receive audio, visual, or data signals, or playback recorded media. Items must be installed using bolts or brackets, including slide-out brackets;
- b. Sidecars;
- c. Custom paint, custom plating, custom seats and custom exhaust;
- d. Safety riding apparel. This includes safety apparel specifically designed to minimize injury from an accident. Certain exclusions will apply. Please refer to endorsement **TMA 0004-E** for additional details.

### Eligibility

The vehicle to which this endorsement applies must have purchased Comprehensive and Collision or Limited Collision. If Comprehensive and Collision or Limited Collision is deleted this coverage will also be deleted.

The *Motorcycle Accessory Coverage* endorsement TMA 0004-E must be attached to the policy.

This endorsement includes changes that affect your auto policy. Please read this endorsement carefully to see how it affects your policy.

For a vehicle to be eligible for this coverage, a premium charge must be shown for Comprehensive and Collision or Limited Collision on the Coverage Selections Page for that vehicle. If Comprehensive, Collision or Limited Collision is deleted this coverage will also be deleted.

### Coverage

We will pay for direct and accidental damage to or loss of **accessories** on your motorcycle for which this coverage has been purchased. **Accessories** include, but are not limited to:

- A. Permanently installed electronic equipment, antennas, and other devices used exclusively to send or receive audio, visual, or data signals, or playback recorded media. Items must be installed using bolts or brackets, including slide-out brackets;
- B. Sidecars;
- C. Custom paint, custom plating, custom seats and custom exhaust;
- D. Safety riding apparel. This includes safety apparel specifically designed to minimize injury from an accident.

Damage or loss must be to a motorcycle described on the Coverage Selections Page for which a premium charge is shown for Comprehensive, Collision or Limited Collision (Parts 7, 8 & 9). Damage or loss must result from a covered collision or loss under one of these purchased coverages.

Coverage will not apply for loss:

- 1. Sustained while any vehicle is being operated in a prearranged or organized racing, speed, stunting or demolition contest or activity, or in practice or preparation for any such contest or activity;
- 2. To portable equipment, devices, **accessories**, and other personal effects not permanently installed. This includes, but is not limited to:
  - a. Tapes, CDs, cassettes, DVDs and other recording or recorded media;
  - b. Containers designed for use in storing or carrying tapes, CDs, cassettes, DVDs, or other recording or recorded media;
  - c. Devices used for the detection or location of radar, laser, or other speed measuring equipment or its transmissions; and
  - d. Telephones, CB and two way mobile radios, DVD players, personal computers, personal digital assistants, or televisions;
- 3. To **accessories** in excess of the applicable limits of coverage; or
- 4. To safety riding apparel. This exclusion does not apply if there is a covered collision or loss to the motorcycle.

The limit of coverage under this part is the lowest of:

- 1. The amount necessary to replace **accessories**;

2. The amount necessary to repair **accessories**; or
3. The limit shown for this coverage under the Additional Information section of the Coverage Selections Page.

The limit for Motorcycle Accessories Coverage shown on the Coverage Selections Page is the most we will pay for any one accident or loss. It is the most we will pay regardless of the number of **accessories** sustaining loss. No deductible applies to this coverage.

The Exclusions for motorcycle **accessories** under Part 7., Part 8. and Part 9. do not apply to the extent that coverage is provided under this endorsement.

All other provisions of the policy apply.
