#### WHAT IS THE NCIA-PAC?

NCIA-PAC is a nonpartisan Political Action Committee (PAC) for cannabis professionals and provides contributions to members of Congress and candidates who support legislation that is favorable to the legal cannabis industry. NCIA-PAC gives cannabis professionals a united voice in the political process. The NCIA-PAC is also a critical component of NCIA's lobbying efforts. It gives our members a voice in supporting elected officials who help the industry by promoting helpful policy and defeating harmful legislation.

### HOW ARE PAC DOLLARS USED?

All PAC contributions are used to support political candidates or committees. PACs can contribute up to \$5,000 to a federal candidate committee per election. PACs may receive up to \$5,000 from any eligible individual, PAC, or party committee per calendar year.

As of June 30, 2018, NCIA-PAC expenditures totaled just over \$50,000 in the mid-term election cycle, with top donations to the following campaigns:
