### INDUSTRY/BUSINESS

#### **H.R. 1810 & S. 777 Small Business Tax Equity Act of 2017**

Amends the Internal Revenue Code to exempt a trade or business that conducts marijuana sales in compliance with state law from the prohibition against allowing business-related tax credits or deductions for expenditures in connection with trafficking in controlled substances.

#### **H.R. 2215 & S. 1152 Secure and Fair Enforcement (SAFE) Banking Act**

Provides a "safe harbor" and additional protections for depository institutions who provide a "financial product or service" to a covered business.

### STATES' RIGHTS

#### **H.R. 975 Respect State Marijuana Laws Act of 2017**

Mandates that those individuals/businesses that are compliant with state marijuana laws are compliant with federal marijuana laws.

#### **H.R. 2528 Respect States' and Citizens Rights Act of 2017**

Amends the Controlled Substances Act (CSA) to declare that no provision of the CSA, including criminal penalties, is intended to supersede or preempt a state law that pertains to marijuana.

#### **H.R. 6043 & S. 3032: Strengthening the Tenth Amendment Through Entrusting States (STATES) Act**

This bill amends the Controlled Substances Act so that its provisions no longer apply to any person acting in compliance with State or tribal laws relating to the manufacture, production, possession, distribution, dispensation, administration, or delivery of cannabis. States that compliant financial transactions are not trafficking and do not result in proceeds of an unlawful transaction.

### TAX & REGULATE

#### **H.R. 1823 & S. 776 Marijuana Revenue and Regulation Act**

Amends the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide for the taxation and regulation of marijuana products, and for other purposes.

#### **H.R. 1824 & S. 780 Responsibly Addressing the Marijuana Policy Gap Act of 2017 (RAMP Act)**

Amends the Controlled Substances Act to reduce the gap between federal and state marijuana policy, and for other purposes.

#### **H.R. 4815 & S. 1689 Marijuana Justice Act of 2017**

To amend the Controlled Substances Act to provide for a new rule regarding the application of the Act to marijuana, and for other purposes.

#### **S. 3174 Marijuana Freedom and Opportunity Act**

Removes cannabis from the Controlled Substances Act. Creates funding for minority and women-owner cannabis businesses, invest in highway safety and public health research, provides for state and local expungement and sealing programs, sets advertising regulations.
