Operations (60%)

- Develop and oversee implementation of reporting, project setup, and metrics critical to contract financial and project management
- Develop, train and manage project manager(s) on contract management functions and processes, including invoicing, monthly budget reviews, and margin performance
- Provide analysis/quality control for submitted proposals, budgets and new contracts
- Ensure contractual compliance and procurement procedures as per USG-funded and other donor-funded projects and opportunities

Financial management (25%)
