RESPONSIBILITIES

Specific skill sets GeoPoll is seeking include:

- *Technical area expertise*—experience in any of the following technical areas: democracy and governance, elections, humanitarian assistance, public health, youth and education, gender development and integration, workforce development, agriculture and food security, water and sanitation, or economic growth and trade.
- *Capacity building expertise* – working with government and civil society organizations (CSOs), demonstrating effective transfer of skills.
- *Monitoring and evaluation expertise*—generalists and specific to technical areas such as democracy and governance, agriculture, and data scientists. Expertise in the following is also desired: impact assessments, research methods and statistics, ICT4D, and mobile technology research.
- *Computer-Assisted Telephone Interviewing (CATI) expertise*—call center set-up management, training, operations, and quality control in developing countries.
- *Program and project implementation expertise*—designing and implementing international development programs. Experience in aid beneficiary engagement and feedback loops also desired.
- *Conflict prevention and resolution expertise*—expertise in the above areas but within fragile and conflict-affected environments.
- *Graphic design, data visualization, storytelling, and/or analytics expertise.*
- *Geographic Information Systems (GIS) expertise.*

QUALIFICATIONS

The proposed Subject Matter Expert must have:

- A minimum of 5 years of practical experience in a senior line or advisory position.
- A minimum of 5 years of relevant experience working with one more donors such as USAID, DFID, World Bank, or GIZ.



- A minimum Master's Degree in economics, finance, accounting, or a related advanced degree relevant to the area of expertise.
- Strong oral and written communication skills.
- Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to work as a part of a team, maintain effective and cooperative relations with national authorities as well as donors, and handle sensitive issues with discretion in a multicultural environment.
- Fluency in English mandatory; fluency in a second language preferred.
- International experience, including Africa or the Middle East.
