

Some Progress...



- August 18 marked 97 years since the 19th amendment to the US constitution was ratified
- Women now serve in high ranking positions in public and private sector
- We've come VERY close to putting a woman in the white house – not as first lady
- There are 3 female members of the AIIM Board of Directors



And Yet...



- Only 6.2% of S & P 500 companies are woman-led
- Women still make \$.80 for every \$1 made by a man
- By 2018 there will be 1.4 million open technology jobs (in the US). Only 29% will be filled by women



How We Rock...



- Companies with the highest gender diversity see a 10% greater return on equity and a 48% higher operating result
- When women are in senior executive positions/on boards, companies achieve a 70% stronger stock price growth
- Having at least 1 woman on a board decreases bankruptcy by 20%


