




A GROWING NUMBER OF GLOBAL CANNABIS CONSUMERS



Cannabis Business Capital Raises by Market Sector 2015-2017




Big Alcohol & Tobacco's Accounted for Nearly Half of 2018's Total Cannabis Investments



EUROPE: LEADING THE WAVE OF CANNABIS REFORM




- Largest wave of cannabis reform & legalization in the world.
- 29 countries allow some form of medical cannabis use, but rules vary widely
- Products allowed range from flower to Sativex & Epidiolex
- Pharmacies (not dispensaries) are the primary distribution channel






ASIA: THE EPICENTER OF GLOBAL HEMP PRODUCTION



- The world's most populous nations, India and China, are major hemp producers
- Thailand is developing a medical cannabis program; aims to be a leading low-cost high quality cannabis exporter
- The CBD markets in Japan in Korea will represent significant opportunity for nutraceuticals and cosmetics




AFRICA: BUILDING MOMENTUM FOR LOW COST PRODUCTION



- Southern Africa is leading cannabis legalization in Africa
- The South African Supreme Court ruled cannabis prohibition violates South Africans' human rights
- Lesotho and Zimbabwe have legalized medical use
- A bill to legalize adult use in Kenya was just introduced
- Zambia, Equatorial Guinea, Liberia, Guinea Bissau all exploring industrial hemp/medical use

OCEANIA: A REGIONAL HUB FOR LEGALIZATION IN THE PACIFIC



- Australia and New Zealand anchor Oceania's cannabis markets, with the highest usage rates in the region.
- Australia is a leading importer,
 but wants to become a global exporter
- New Zealand is on track to be the next developed nation to legalize adult use



LATIN AMERICA: CULTURAL AFFINITY IS DRIVING LEGALIZATION

- Latin American nations have quickly embraced medical cannabis
- Uruguay was the first nation to fully legalize recreational use
- Many countries in the region, including Columbia, Panama, and Uruguay are investing heavily in building export capacity
- Brazil, the regions largest country, remains a CBD-only market




Medical Use



Latin America: Top 5 Largest Cannabis Consumer Nations

The total estimated number of cannabis consumers in Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Mexico, and Argentina account for roughly 80% of **all** cannabis consumers in Latin America











- Uruguay was the first nation to legalize adult use cannabis in 2014.
- There are three ways to obtain recreational cannabis: pharmacies, cannabis clubs, home cultivation
- Adults my only purchase 10g per week/40g per month from pharmacies.
- Cannabis clubs are limited in membership, number of plants, and grams dispensed.
- The only medicinal product available in pharmacies is Epifractan, a 10 ml CBD oil extract with 2% CBD.



KEY TAKEAWAYS

- The entrance of big pharma, alcohol and tobacco is funding expansion & scale
- Courts are now starting to define the rights of cannabis consumers, and laws are consequently evolving
- Countries like Georgia, Mexico and South Africa are some of the first examples where human rights helped shape cannabis policy
- The United Nations is set to release a report on THC at the end of Q1 2019
 - Whatever the outcome, the existence of the report will advance the conversation and shows significant progress
