Driving Directions – West Entry

2330 Granart Road, Sugar Grove, IL 60554

FROM EASTERN AND CENTRAL ILLINOIS / DOWNTOWN CHICAGO

Take the East-West Tollway (I88) going west. Pass towns of Oak Brook, Lisle, Naperville, Aurora. Take the Sugar Grove exit, US 30/56 Illinois Route 47 (3rd exit after the Aurora Toll Booth). DO NOT miss the Sugar Grove exit, the next one is in DeKalb about 20 minutes further west. Follow US 30/56 west for approximately 8 minutes. Once you pass over Route 47, you are about 2 miles from Dugan Road. Aurora Airport will be on your right. Take a left on Dugan Road (2nd stoplight) and use the right lane to head west out of the roundabout on to Granart Road. Go about 1 mile to the entrance of Rich Harvest Farms, which is on the left hand side of the street.

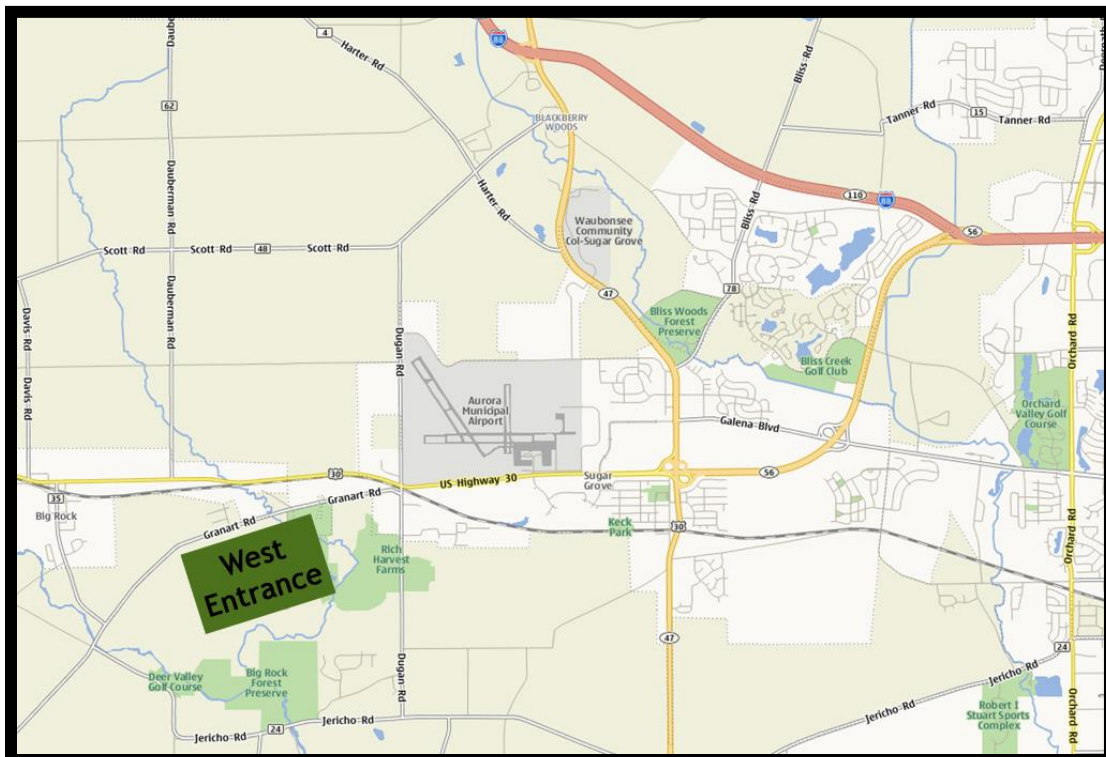
FROM WESTERN ILLINOIS / DEKALB

Take the East-West Tollway (I88) going east towards Chicago. Exit Route 47 (Exit 109) to Sugar Grove and turn right (south). Take Route 47 for about 4 miles until US 30. Exit west on US 30. FROM EASTERN AND CENTRAL ILLINOIS / DOWNTOWN CHICAGO

Take the East-West Tollway (I88) going west. Pass towns of Oak Brook, Lisle, Naperville, Aurora. Take the Sugar Grove exit, US 30/56 Illinois Route 47 (3rd exit after the Aurora Toll Booth). DO NOT miss the Sugar Grove exit, the next one is in DeKalb about 20 minutes further west. Follow US 30/56 west for approximately 8 minutes. Once you pass over Route 47, you are about 2 miles from Dugan Road. Aurora Airport will be on your right. 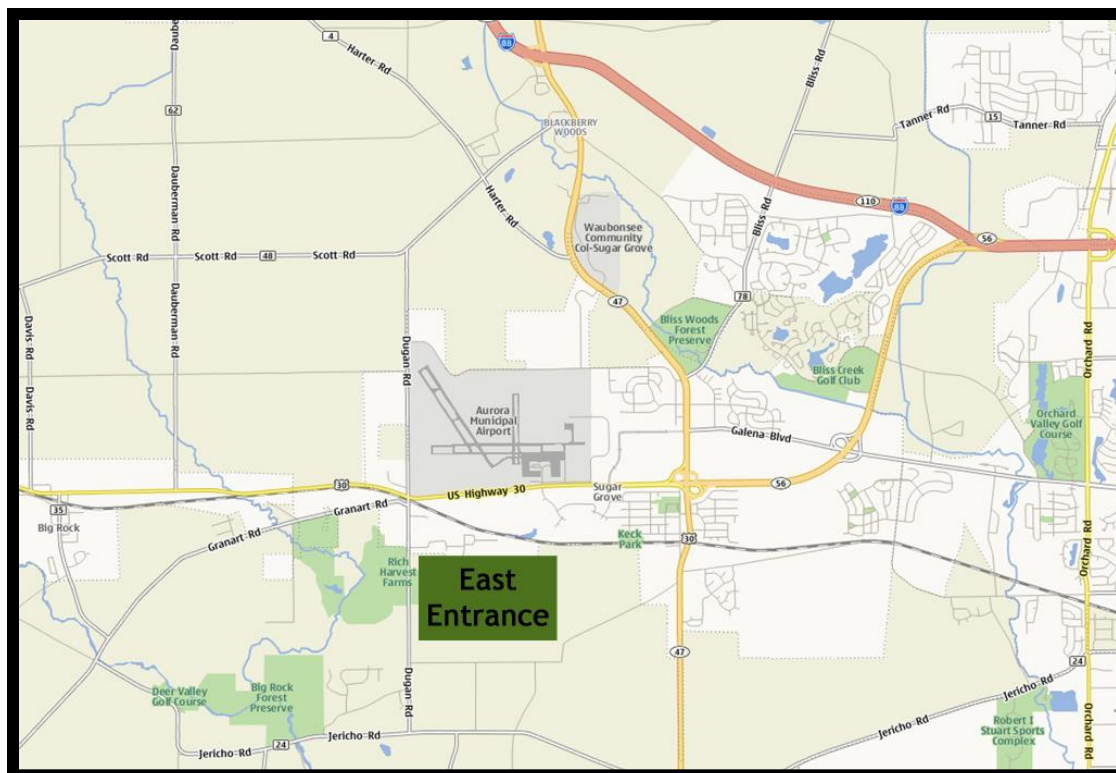
FROM WESTERN ILLINOIS / DEKALB

Between Entrances

FROM WEST ENTRY TO EAST ENTRY

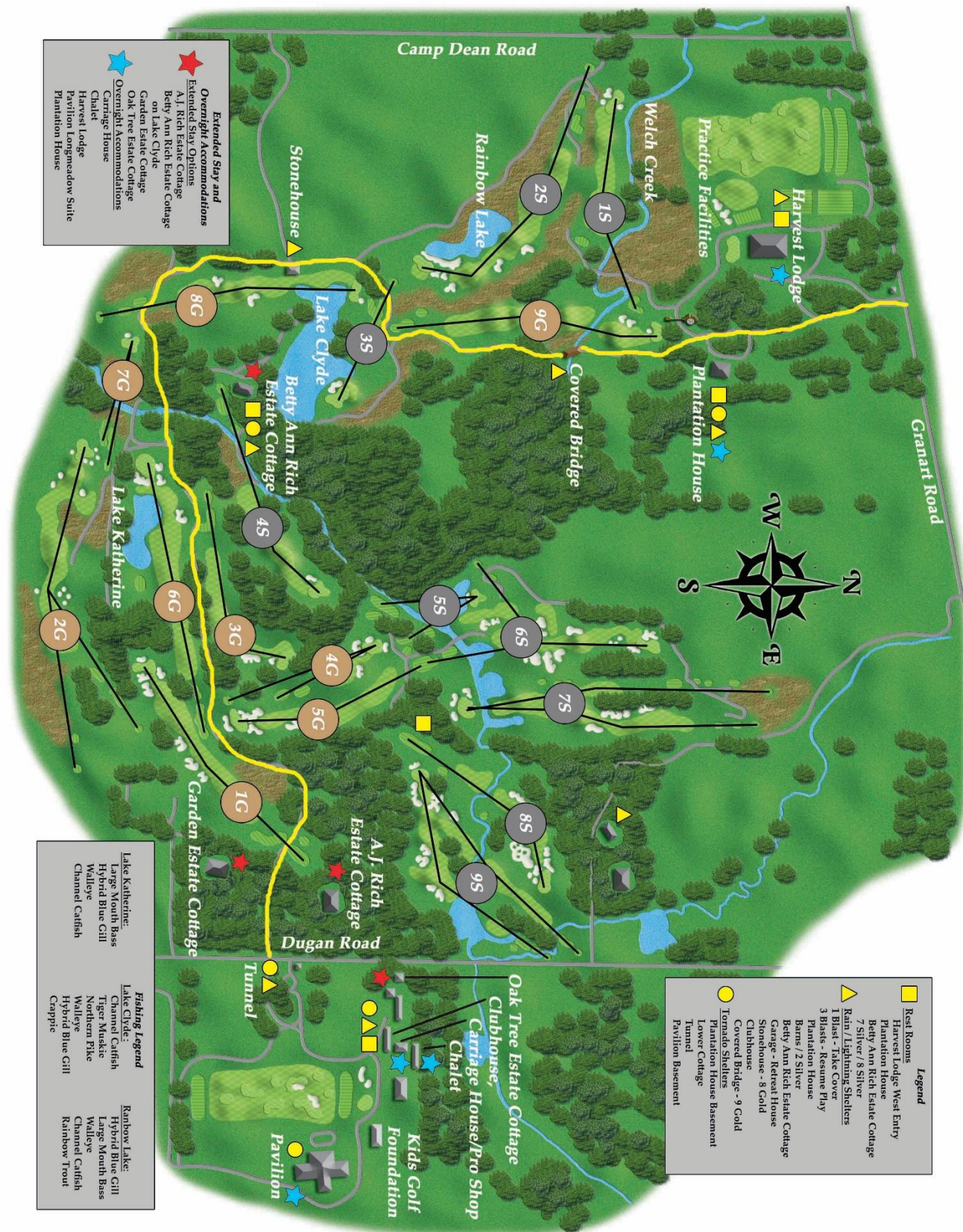
Once outside the guard gate, take a right to head East on Granart Road. Use the right lane and take the first right out of the roundabout to head South on Dugan Road. Continue straight about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to the East Entry guard gate located on the left hand side of the street. If you pass St. Katherine Drexel Church, you have gone too far. *Please stop at the gate. Security will check you in and inform you where to go.*

FROM EAST ENTRY TO WEST ENTRY

Take a right out of the East Entrance to head north on Dugan Road. Take the third exit out of the roundabout to head West on Granart Road. Go about 1 mile to the entrance of Rich Harvest Farms, which is on the left hand side of the street. The entrance is marked with a stone guard house and two white gates; flag poles are in a flowerbed in front. *Please stop at the flowerbed in front of the Guard House to access the intercom box and press the button to request entry.*

Harvest Lodge Overnight Guests

Please stop at the flowerbed in front of the Guard House to access the intercom box and press the button to request entry. Provide the security guard with your name and the name of the sponsoring Member or corporation. Proceed and park in the Harvest Lodge Main Parking Lot located on your right after entering the property and closest to the building. Once you have parked, you will be greeted by a member of the Rich Harvest Farms Hospitality staff. Please wait in the Harvest Lodge Parking Lot until a staff member has met you to provide further instructions.

Plantation House

Please stop at the flowerbed in front of the Guard House to access the intercom box and press the button to request entry. Provide the security guard with your name and the name of the sponsoring Member or corporation. Proceed to the Plantation House Parking Lot located on your left and just north of the Plantation House. You will be greeted inside by a member of the Rich Harvest Farms.

Pavilion Event Guests

Please stop at the Guard House and provide the security guard with your name and the name of the sponsoring Member of corporation. The security guard will provide you with further details to proceed to park to the north or behind the Pavilion. The entrance to the Pavilion is on the front of the building and faces north, just beside the large doors that face the driving range.

East Entry Golf – Pro Shop/Clubhouse

Please stop at the Guard House and provide the security guard with your name and the name of the sponsoring member or corporation. The security guard will provide you with further details to proceed to the parking lot. Please pull up to the podium located in the parking lot where you will be greeted by a member of the Rich Harvest Farms staff who will valet your car.

Cellular Devices

At Rich Harvest Farms, the use of cellular phones is allowed in all areas. However, we ask that you are courteous of our Membership and other guests and have your ringers on vibrate mode.

Attire

Golf Course

Only traditional and appropriate golf attire may be worn on the golf course and practice facilities. Bermuda length shorts (at least 17 inches for men) are permitted and golf or collared sport shirts are required (no tank tops or t-shirts). Mock turtleneck shirts are also considered appropriate. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Cargo shorts are not allowed. Ladies may not wear short shorts, tank tops or halter tops. Blue jean/denim clothing of any type is not permitted and hats must be removed inside all buildings.

Plantation House Attire

Breakfast and Lunch: golf attire as listed above or business casual attire is appropriate attire during breakfast and lunch hours in the Plantation House. All hats must be removed while inside the Plantation House.

Dinner: Unless otherwise specified on your event agenda, parties dining in the Formal Dining Room at the Plantation House are required to wear formal attire. For men, long pants and a sport jacket are required. For ladies, the equivalent to business attire is appropriate.

Indoor Arena Attire

During evening activities in the Indoor Arena, casual attire is permitted.

Rental clubs are available upon request at a fee of \$50 per day. Please be sure to reserve before your arrival.

Practice Facilities

The practice facilities are provided at no charge as part of your experience at Rich Harvest Farms typically an hour before your scheduled tee off time or as stated prior to your arrival.

Club Shipping

For out of town guests, Rich Harvest Farms staff can accept or ship out golf clubs via ship sticks. Please inform the staff prior to arrival if clubs will be arriving ahead of time and if shipping needs to be done upon departure. All shipping charges will be billed to guests accordingly.

Consistently ranked in *Golf Digest's* America's 100 Greatest Golf Courses, Rich Harvest Farms is an ultra-private, members-only club located in Sugar Grove, Illinois. Owned and co-built by Jerry Rich, the course consists of 18 perfectly manicured holes and is a 1,820-acre showcase of nature and agriculture. With state-of-the-art meeting spaces, numerous lodging options and non-golf amenities that include a private car museum, miles of horseback riding trails and three fully stocked lakes for fishing, Rich Harvest Farms offers its Members and guests distinguished facilities in a luxurious setting.

Rich Harvest Farms represents a true links-style setup with players heading out for nine holes, then back in for the remaining nine. The par-72 design can be played from 6,000 to 7,700 yards. Jerry Rich's influence can be found in many areas around the facility, including the naming of each hole, which reflects his inspiration for the course.
