Data Definition Wizard

- Added a "clear all fields" button on the Identify Fields screen
- Ensure suggested table name doesn't end with an underscore and become "hidden"

Commands

- Enhanced the COMPARE command to behave like VERIFY when it encounters maximum number of errors
- · Added the ability for fields to be moved up/down in command dialogs
- Allowed SQL relational tables as the child file for RELATIONS

Edit Table Layout

- Widened the List View, and shortened the filter area
- Now displays the "flattened" data rather than the raw delimited data

General

- Launched the Spanish version
- · Updated some of the buttons on the button bar
- FMT files can now be added to the object list even if they have been dynamically created since the project was first opened
- Added information in properties to include the ORDER information for relational database tables
- Optimized date field conversions

LegacyLink[™]

 Improved the LegacyLink install so it detects if there is already a project specified so it isn't overwritten during the update

Windows Server

Added a pop-up dialog with any native SQL errors encountered when accessing relational database tables

 Added a warning message if the output prefix is empty or invalid when attempting to connect

 Added the ability to compress output data written by Arbutus. This provides 'Zip-level' compression of 85% or more, without affecting performance
