What is a Workstation Crane?

A workstation crane is a type of overhead crane that is used to lift or move lighter duty loads in a small work area. Workstation cranes are typically lighter-duty systems, lifting materials from 150 lbs. up to 2 tons in capacity. They're designed for repetitive lifting of loads, increasing worker productivity, and to ease work flow.

Configurations

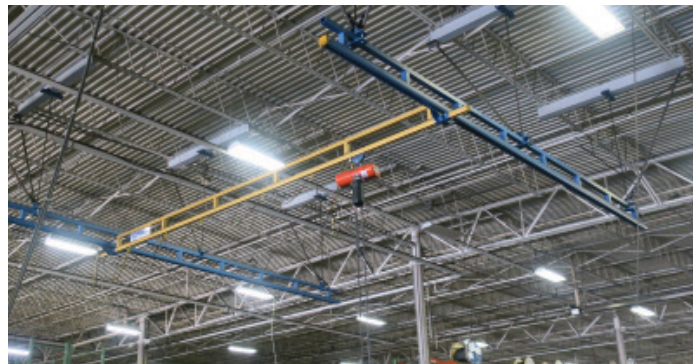
Workstation cranes can be freestanding or ceiling hung. They can also be designed with top running or bottom running bridges. Workstation cranes are appealing because they're versatile, able to be customized, and can be expanded via modular design.

Applications

Workstation cranes are applied to situations where a small overhead lifting system can benefit the workflow in a specific area. They are most often found in indoor warehouses in a work area designated for one to two employees.
