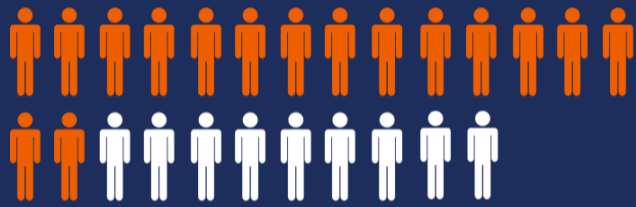
Incidents of serious workplace violence were **4X MORE COMMON** in healthcare than in private industry.\*

The overall violent crime rate at U.S. hospitals last year increased compared to the previous year

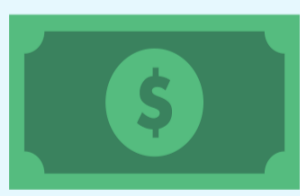
