HOW TO CLEAN Q2 STAINS

Q2 fabrics can be cleaned without the use of special cleaning agents.

Common Household Stains	Solvent-Based Stains	Discoloring Stains
<p>Iodine, Ketchup, Mustard, Red Wine, Chocolate</p> <hr/> <p>Oil-based stains can be removed with conventional detergents such as Tide®, All®, or Gain®.</p>	<p>Lipstick, Nail Polish, Ballpoint Pen, Felt Tip Pen, Shoe Polish</p> <hr/> <p>Solvent-based stains can be removed with 100 percent pure acetone.</p>	<p>Denim, Other Textiles</p> <hr/> <p>Discoloring caused by crocking of dye stuffs used on other textiles can be removed using a solution of 1 part bleach to 10 parts water.</p>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Fresh stains should be removed with a clean cloth. Dried-on stains should be soaked prior to cleaning.• Wash off the stain with the soapy solution using a sponge.• Wash off remaining soap with plenty of clean water.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Carefully apply acetone around the stain.• Absorb with a soft, clean, white, absorbent cloth as soon as stain dissolves.• Procedure may have to be repeated.• Acetone will disappear completely.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dab discolored area with the bleach solution.• Particles will be dissolved within 15-20 minutes.• Absorb the dissolved dye stuffs particles with a clean, white cloth.• Thoroughly rinse out remaining chlorine bleach solution.
