Here is your guide to police salaries for 2017/18. In the tables below you'll find the basic salaries, but if you're a London or south-based officer you'll need to add your allowance as listed on the final page.

Bonus payment

In addition to the annual salaries, officers have been awarded an additional non-consolidated payment to the value of 1% of basic pay (using 2016/17 pay rates) for all officers at federated and superintending ranks to be paid monthly over the next 12 months.
