

AFFILIATE CLASS[®] TRAINER PROGRAM

The Affiliate CLASS Trainer program is designed to build an organization's capacity to scale CLASS data collection and to conduct ongoing observations to measure improvement.



What organizations participate in the Affiliate CLASS Trainer program?

- + Organizations that want to scale their CLASS assessment capabilities
- + Organizations looking to build an in-house CLASS expert who can offer introductory CLASS training to staff and train new observers

Who should become an Affiliate CLASS Trainer?

- + Certified CLASS Observers seeking to expand their CLASS impact by creating new observers and offering introductory trainings
- + Coaches, observers and other instructional leaders seeking to deepen their CLASS knowledge and develop their training and facilitation skills

What age levels are available for the Affiliate CLASS Trainer program?

The program is available for Infant, Toddler, Pre-K, and K-3 age levels.

Please note:

- o Infant requires the participant to be a Certified Affiliate CLASS Trainer in one other age level
- o The Infant Train-the-Trainer program is two days versus three days for other age levels

How does the Affiliate CLASS Trainer program work?

Participants begin the program by participating in the three-day Train-the-Trainer course which provides:

- + In-depth CLASS content knowledge
- + Training facilitation skills

Completion of the training program culminates in a one-year Affiliate CLASS Trainer certification and standard restricted training license, which enables trainers to conduct official CLASS trainings for colleagues within a single, Teachstone-approved organization, including:

- + CLASS Observation Training to create Certified CLASS Observers
- + Introduction to the CLASS Tool training to increase basic understanding of the framework

Please note: The standard license is restricted, meaning that trainers may not charge participant fees and may only train individuals within their specific organization. These licenses are signed with the individual participant rather than their organization.

What if I need to deliver CLASS training to more than one organization?

Teachstone understands that individuals and organizations sometimes need to train a broader audience, depending on their goals and resources. As a result, alternative trainer licensing opportunities are available on a case-by-case basis and subject to additional licensing fees and quality checks.

What is included in the affiliate trainer program?

- + Three-day Train-the-Trainer course
- + Access to webinars and resources designed specifically for Affiliate CLASS Trainers
- + Observation reliability support
- + Access to the affiliate trainer group in the online CLASS Learning Community

Program prerequisites:

- + Current CLASS observer certification in the same age group
- + Recertification required within two months of attending training
- + Completed Train-the-Trainer registration form and knowledge assessment
