Eligibility Requirements

To enroll in the CDA with CLASS® you must:

1. Sign up during an open enrollment period
2. Be a high school graduate

Program Details

CDA with CLASS:

1. The CDA with CLASS includes three (3) sequential courses:
 - Course 1: Understanding Child Development
 - Course 2: Health, Safety, and Environment
 - Course 3: Application to Teaching and Learning
 -
2. You must complete and pass each course in accordance with the course syllabus before beginning the next course in the program.
3. You must apply for your [CDA credential](#) on the Council for Professional Recognition website.

OR

CDA Renewal with CLASS:

1. CDA renewal with CLASS includes one (1) course: Interactions Matter
2. You must complete and pass the course.
3. You must apply to renew your [CDA credential](#) on the Council for Professional Recognition website.

Program Start Dates:

- June 3, 2019 – Enrollment open May 6 to May 27
- July 22, 2019 – Enrollment open June 24 to July 15
- September 9, 2019 – Enrollment open August 12 to September 2
- October 28, 2019 – Enrollment open October 1 to October 21
- December 16, 2019 – Enrollment open November 19 to December 9

Enrollment

What do I need for enrollment?

- Your desired start date (Based on program start dates)
- Date of birth
- Preferred age-level: Pre-K or Infant/Toddler
- A valid credit card number*

During enrollment, you will also be asked to sign our Student Agreement.

Drop Period

You can cancel your enrollment and participation in CDA with CLASS® or CDA Renewal with CLASS® on or prior to day 1 of the start of Course One or the renewal course with no financial penalty. After that drop period, tuition is non-refundable.

Obtaining Your Credential

After you have completed all three courses or the renewal course, you are eligible to apply for your CDA credential or renew your credential from the Council of Professional Recognition.
