

# Video DOT for Tuberculosis Treatment

Directly Observed Therapy (DOT) is the gold standard for adherence to tuberculosis treatment. emocha's HIPAA-compliant video DOT platform is a novel, patient-centric solution that has been clinically validated to achieve adherence rates comparable to in-person DOT and save public health resources.



## Patient App

Patients use emocha's mobile app to video record themselves taking their medication, report potential side effects or symptoms, and receive engagement and support. The app is available for iOS, Android, and tablet devices in more than 20 languages.

## Care Team Web Portal & App

Care teams use emocha's web platform to review videos, assess side effects, and engage with patients to ensure DOT guidelines are met. Providers can also use a companion app to record and centralize in-person DOT visits and symptoms.
