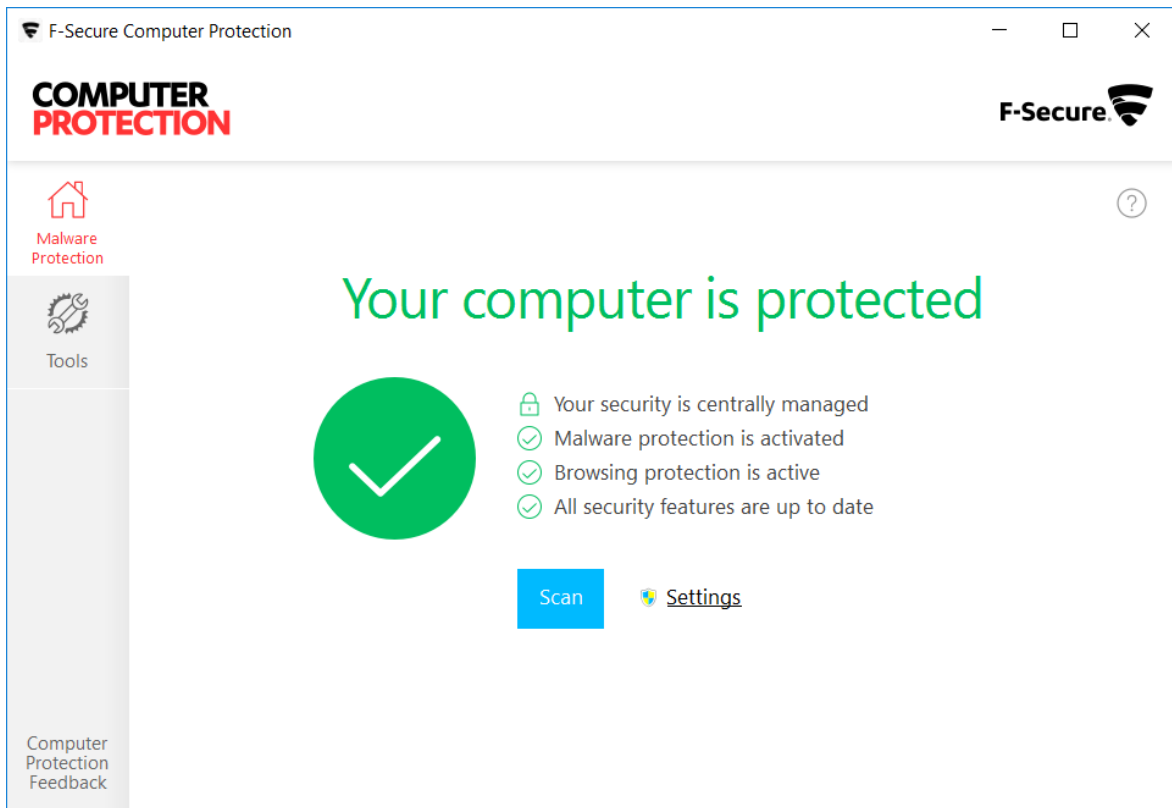




F-Secure Computer Protection: Main differences compared to Workstation Security 12

F-Secure Computer Protection product is a replacement for PSB for Workstations in the PSB product line.



F-Secure Computer Protection has been now made available for all solution provider level users of PSB. Each solution provider can decide if they want to make it available for the Companies under them.

Major changes in Computer Protection

- Anti-malware:
 - Significantly revised scanning architecture using the latest technology from the F-Secure Lab.
 - Unifies behavior of security components and brings the possibility to add new security features more easily in the future.
- Firewall:
 - Remotely managed Microsoft Firewall.
 - Firewall profiles have been updated to handle the most significant threats.

- Software updater:
 - Currently it is using exactly same software updater technology as PSB Workstation Security 12.
- User Interface:
 - Refreshed and revised.
- Common:
 - Installer is currently only available as a network installer.
 - Silent Computer Protection upgrades without the need to reboot the computer.
 - Completely revised update technology, bringing significant reduction in network bandwidth usage.
 - Many performance and stability improvements.
 - Extendible client architecture, allowing easier integration of new features in the future.
- Features dropped:
 - Support for Windows Vista
 - Email and Spam scanning

Features to be delivered later (incrementally)

- Scheduled scanning
- Neighborcast
- Profile migration from current PSB WS12 series profiles
- 12 series channel upgrade, so that devices automatically use the migrated profiles
- Upgrade groups for Computer Protection upgrade, so solution providers can better distribute when upgrades happen to their companies.
- Single installer, so you can install the whole product from USB-stick or via some software distribution solution.
