SUPPLIES TOILET PAPER ROLLS YELLOW PAINT GOOGLY EYES PIPE CLEANERS CONSTRUCTION PAPER CRAFT GLUE MARKERS SCISSORS POM POMS Prepare your cardboard tubes by painting them yellow and then allowing them to dry. Once dry, take your black marker and color 3 stripes across the body of the bee. Next, we recommend that the supervising adult poke one hole with a pair of scissors on each side of the cardboard tube. This is where the pipe cleaners will turn into legs, so you want to make sure they're relatively even. Next, cut your black pipe cleaner into two sections approximately 4 inches long. Thread the pipe cleaners through the holes, and you'll have little bug legs!

For the wings, fold a red piece of construction paper in half, and draw a medium-sized heart, cutting through the folded paper to make two wings—one for each side. Use a black marker to create a personalized design on each wing. Place a drop of craft glue at the point of each wing and attach to the back side of the toilet paper role. Be sure to place toward the middle of the body, so your wings appear centered.

Finally, cut two additional black pipe cleaners into strips approximately 4 inches long. Place craft glue on one end of each pipe cleaner and place just inside the opening at the top of the bee's head. Finish your bee-autiful creation by placing a drop of craft glue on the back of each googly eye and placing on the face. Let your love bug dry for 30 minutes before taking it out to play. Place your cute little bee around your home or in your child's room as fun décor.
