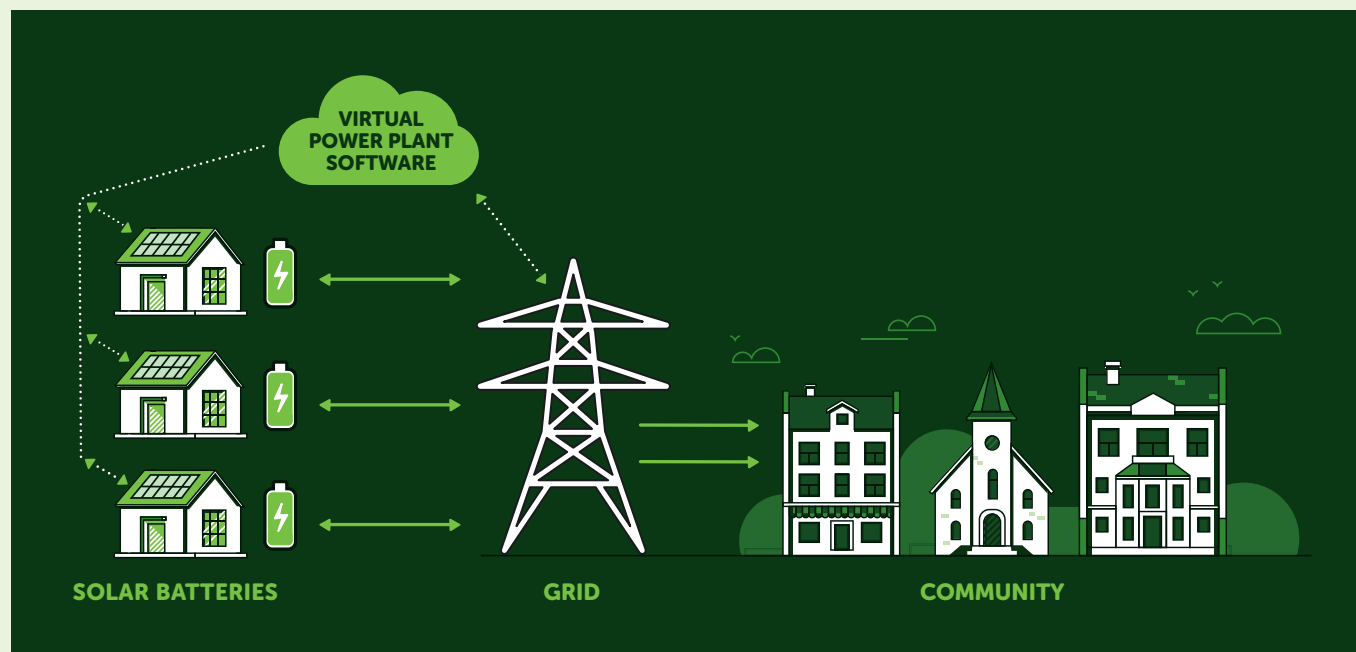

So what is a virtual power plant?

A virtual power plant is a group of home solar batteries, all remotely connected, that can be used as an additional power resource to the grid. These batteries are called on to help the grid when it's under pressure - like during heat waves, when everyone suddenly turns on their aircon.



How does our virtual power plant (VPP) work?

1. During periods of high demand, we may remotely charge and discharge energy from batteries in the VPP to the grid.
2. You'll receive \$20 each time this happens, plus your solar feed-in tariff for any energy exported to the grid.*

You won't even notice a difference but you'll make a difference:

When we need to access your battery for the VPP, it should only last a couple hours[^] and we'll always SMS you beforehand – but don't worry, you won't even notice a change to your house's electricity supply.

Start saving money and support more use of renewable energy:

You'll need to be an EnergyAustralia electricity customer to join the initiative^{^^} – but switching is easy and well worth the \$1000 bonus credit you'll receive on your account. Terms and conditions apply.
