Custodial Information Management/Internal Threat Mitigation for Defence Supply Chain Members: This one-day seminar will address the mandatory legislations that companies must comply with (NDB / GDPR), before moving on to Defence specific regulations like ITAR / NIST SP 800-171. Custodial Information Security and a definition of how it differs from traditional network/perimeter security solutions. Will also be addressed through a mixture of case histories and specific examples.

Advanced Defence ISO: A one-day seminar that will look at the higher-level ISO and Quality requirements for the supply chain, including in areas such as configuration and asset management and Quality Plans.
