Fostering social and emotional development


Social and emotional learning (SEL) has become a focus for many schools and districts aiming to facilitate safe, positive learning environments in which students are equipped not only to succeed academically, but to gain the skills they need to understand and manage their emotions. Creating a school- or district-wide culture in which SEL remains a consistent priority, however, can be challenging.

Students who participated in evidence-based SEL programs showed an 11 percentile-point gain in academic achievement. They also showed improved classroom behavior, an increased ability to manage stress and depression, and better attitudes about themselves, others, and their school compared to students who did not participate in SEL programs.


