CHALLENGE

Speaking anxiety and lack of motivation among students

For Dr. Appleby, preparing students of varying skill levels and comfort zones for conversations with French language partners was a consistent challenge. Lacking motivation, students were not regularly practicing their language skills outside of the classroom.

After holiday breaks, Dr. Appleby found that she had to start from scratch, spending valuable class time reviewing previous material. "Often when students return from a break, it seems as though they've forgotten practically everything."

For the College's International Education Week, international students representing 11 different countries were able to share their native languages with peers using Mango's courses in Mandarin Chinese, Danish, Hindi, Japanese, Brazilian Portuguese, and even Scottish Gaelic.
