From December 1997-August 2007 transfer and Study Away grades were included in the honors calculations while Physical Education activity courses were excluded. From December 2007 forward, graduation honors are determined by the cumulative grade point average of all PLU coursework and students must complete a minimum of 64 hours at PLU to be eligible. Study Away courses count toward the 64-hour minimum but do not count in the honors calculation.
