Juniata Elementary School Is "Adding" On, Which "Spells" Another Quality Project By Lacy Construction

Okay, that's enough with the puns; I guess you could say they're "History." Can you imagine having a home-cooked meal prepared for you every day of the week? Well, that's what the children at Juniata Elementary School

can look forward to. Homemade bread and cinnamon rolls made from scratch are just a few items on the menu.

You're probably wondering how we know all this. Well, Juniata Elementary School is adding on, and Lacy was the

firm selected to build the approximately 3,000-square-foot addition, which will give the school space for a new music room, media center and computer lab. The school faculty can hardly wait for the extra space to be ready so they can spread out and have more room to breathe.

Kenn Frederick, project architect for Cannon Moss Brygger & Associates, was responsible for the design. The new addition is a block building with a brick veneer to match the existing structure. The roof consists of a double-sloped steel truss system over the media center that ties into single slope roofs over the music room and

computer lab. This roof system, though challenging, adds character to the front of the building. Among the exterior architectural features are stone windowsills, aluminum windows and an architectural metal panel system on the fascia. One very special aspect of the exterior is a bell tower that houses the bell from the original Juniata School.

After the addition is complete, we'll also be performing some remodel work to the existing building, including new offices, a new walk-in freezer, new floor coverings and a fire sprinkler system. By the start of school this August, Juniata will have a wonderful new addition and plenty of extra space to grow.

The new facility will allow CNH to keep all of its in-process parts stored indoors while awaiting assembly.
