Lexington's New Library Opens Ahead of Schedule

The Lexington Library opened its doors to the City of Lexington late last fall, two weeks ahead of schedule. The spacious library provides lots of room to move around and grow in the future. Another unique feature of the library is the four private study rooms that are available to small study groups.
