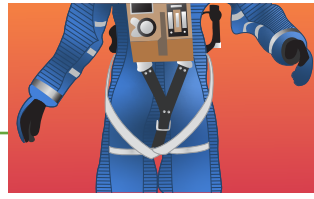
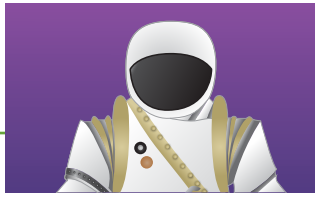

Challenge Rules

About the Challenge

The Museum of Flight is excited to announce a Spacesuit Design Challenge for all designers ages 5 to 17! This year is the 50th anniversary of humans walking on the Moon, and what better way to celebrate than creating custom spacesuits? Whether traveling to the Moon, Mars, or beyond, the ingenuity of spacesuits keeps astronauts safe from potentially harmful environments. We are looking for unique spacesuits that incorporate similar safety features seen in functional spacesuits.

Note: your spacesuit does not need to be functional in a low gravity environment, but it must be wearable.

Contest

The top 15 Spacesuit designs will be showcased in the Top 15 Fashion Show at The Museum of Flight's Lunar Block Party on Friday, July 19. A panel of judges will decide the top three designs, one for each age category. The three winning spacesuits will be displayed in the Museum's Alaska Airlines Aerospace Education Center.

Prizes

Top 15 – Each designer (*plus two - one must be a legal guardian*) will receive free admission to The Museum of Flight, *Destination Moon: The Apollo 11 Mission* exhibition, and a ticket to *Lunar Block Party's Friday Evening Event*.

Top 3 – Each winner will have their spacesuit displayed in the *Alaska Airlines Aerospace Education Center* at The Museum of Flight.

Note: Each participant must bring a legal guardian to the Fashion Show.

Judging Criteria

Top 15 – Designs are chosen based on:

- Creativity
- Following the Challenge Rules

Top 3 – At the Fashion Show, designs are chosen based on:

- Creativity
- Following the Challenge Rules
- Presentation on the runway (*hair, walk, etc*)

Rules

1. One submission per designer.
2. Spacesuits must be original and handmade.
 - 2.1. Spacesuits may contain pre-made articles, however there must be obvious modifications.
3. Spacesuits may not include glitter, helium balloons, dirt/sand, live animals, weaponry, illegal substances, or offensive language or imagery of any kind.
4. Top 15 designers are required to wear their spacesuit in the Fashion Show if chosen to participate.
 - 4.1. *There must be at least one legal guardian with each designer.*

Age Groups

In the spirit of fairness, we will have three age groups to compete in. The age groups are Comet (ages 5–8), Nebula (ages 9–13) and Galaxy (ages 14–17).

Transport

If your spacesuit is chosen to compete in the Top 15 Fashion Show, you will be responsible for delivering it safely to the Museum that day. Spacesuits must be worn during the Fashion Show on July 19th, 2019. If you are one of the finalists, The Museum of Flight will display your spacesuit in the *Alaska Airlines Aerospace Education Center from July 19-26*. You will be responsible for retrieving your spacesuit by July 26, 2019.

Ownership

Designers retain full ownership of their spacesuits.

Designer Biography

When you submit your intent to participate, please also send us your biography and any information about special projects, hobbies, or interests you may have. About 200-300 words.

Entry Packet

Before filling out the Entry Packet, read through all information, including the Dates to Remember. To participate in the Spacesuit Design Challenge, fill out the following:

- Intent to participate
- Photo Release Form
- Designer Biography
- Design Description
- Design Drawing

Dates to Remember

May 31, 2019 – Entry packet due by 5 p.m. PST. Please include your biography, spacesuit design description, and a drawing of your design. Designers will be contacted within 1 business day for confirmed receipt of packet.

June 1 to July 4, 2019 – Design/create Spacesuits once you receive confirmation (*total of five weeks*).

July 5, 2019 – 2-4 images of completed spacesuit due by 5 p.m. PST. Email to esimmons@museumofflight.org.

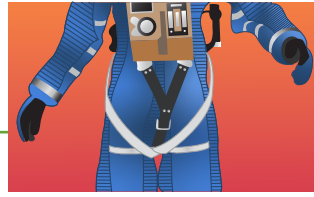
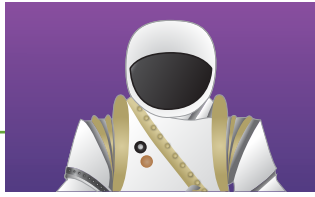
July 15, 2019 – Designers notified on whether or not they will participate in the Top 15 Fashion Show.

July 19, 2019 – Top 15 Fashion Show at The Museum of Flight during *Lunar Block Party's Friday Evening Event* at 6 p.m. PST Arrive by 5:30 p.m.

July 19 to 26, 2019 – The Top 3 spacesuits will be displayed in the *Alaska Airlines Aerospace Education Center*.

July 26, 2019 – Designers retrieve spacesuits by 7 p.m. PST.
