

Suggested Feeding Rates Per Day – Thorvin

Mix in feed at 1 to 2% of grain ration or 0.1 to 0.5% of Dry Matter Intake (DMI), depending on the species. Thorvin can also be fed free choice, alone or with salt, or top dressed.

Poultry	0.5%	1%	—	—	Top Dress
Swine	0.5%	1%	—	—	Top Dress

For feeding dogs and cats, see below for Feed Rates by Species.

*1/2 oz. = 1 Tbsp. and 2 oz. = 1/4 cup ** Generally, mix no more than 1/2 oz. with the amount of grain eaten per horse per day.
