## TYPES OF AID AWARDED TO USF STUDENTS

### Grants

Money provided by the federal or state government or institution that is based on need. Does not need to be repaid.

### Scholarships

Money provided based on academic performance or talent (e.g., athletics, music, etc.). Does not need to be repaid.

### Loans

Money borrowed by you and/or your parents that must be paid back with interest. Loans may be awarded to you regardless of financial need.

### Work Study

Need-based employment. Money is received bimonthly based upon hours worked in an on-campus job.

## HOW TO APPLY FOR AID

- 1 Visit [fafsa.gov](https://fafsa.gov) to start your 2023-24 FAFSA.
- 2 Create an FSA ID.
- 3 Use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) to import your (and your parents') federal tax data.
- 4 Enter USF's school code 001537.
- 5 Use your FSA ID to electronically sign and submit the FAFSA.

## AID DEADLINES - MARK YOUR CALENDAR

### Oct. 1, 2022

2023-24 FAFSA becomes available

### Jan. 1, 2023

Priority Deadline: Submit your FAFSA by this date to be considered for the most types of aid possible.

### January 15, 2023

Submit a complete application for admission by this date to be considered for admissions scholarships.

### MAY, 15, 2023

Final Deadline: Submit your FAFSA by this date to be considered for Summer or Fall 2023 aid.
