Step 1 - Press 'Settings' on your devices main menu screen



Step 2 - Press 'Auto Adjust Gradation'

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Step 3 - Choose your stock- 'Plain (80gsm)' or 'Heavy' and press 'Full Adjustment'.

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Step 4 - Select the paper source in which the paper type you selected in step 3 is set, and press 'OK'.

Step 5 - Press 'Start Printing'



Step 6 - Place the first test page on the platen glass and press 'Start Scanning'



Follow these steps until you have printed and scanned four test charts, Auto Grade Completed and print quality should now be improved .
